The property has Lynch's Creek frontage, natural springs, spring fed dams and a fully equipped bore as its water supply plus water troughs. The Bore water is as good as pure and is used for the drinking water at the house.

The land is undulating and runs from Kikuyu creek flats running up to fertile basalt soil plateaus covered with green feed and heaps of usable timber.

All the fences on the property are in very good to new condition and there are many tracks to get around the property which is subdivided into 3 main grazing paddocks.

Timbers include brush box, tallow wood, flooded gum, blue gum, Ironbark, Black Bean, Red Cedar and Bloodwood plus native palms, stag horns and grass trees.
