The home is warmed by a combustion heater and a split-level air conditioner plus fans and a nice breeze that breathes through the homestead. The kitchen has many timber features and a gas stove any cook would love. There are 3 large bedrooms, rumpus room, french doors, gas hot water, solar back into the grid and a recently renovated bathroom plus much more.

There are manicured gardens surrounding the "Marindah" homestead which is accessed by coming up your own private driveway and through to the double carport. The shed will also accommodate up to 10 vehicles. In the shed there is a shower, toilet, change room and power connected.

The 44 acres has a beautiful frontage to Smith's Creek, two other spring fed dams for the horses and cattle and ample rainwater storage tanks for the house and shed. The property is fenced into several grazing paddocks and all with access to water. The steel stockyards have a vet crush and steel
